## Minutes from the February Meeting

### CAM Meeting Minutes-3/13/14

President Joe Healy called the meeting to order at 7 P.M.

A motion was made and accepted to approve the minutes as posted in the *Pony Express*.

Dale Mashburn gave an update on the museum construction. The storefront window system with a glass garage door will be installed next week. The ceiling tiles will be installed this weekend.
