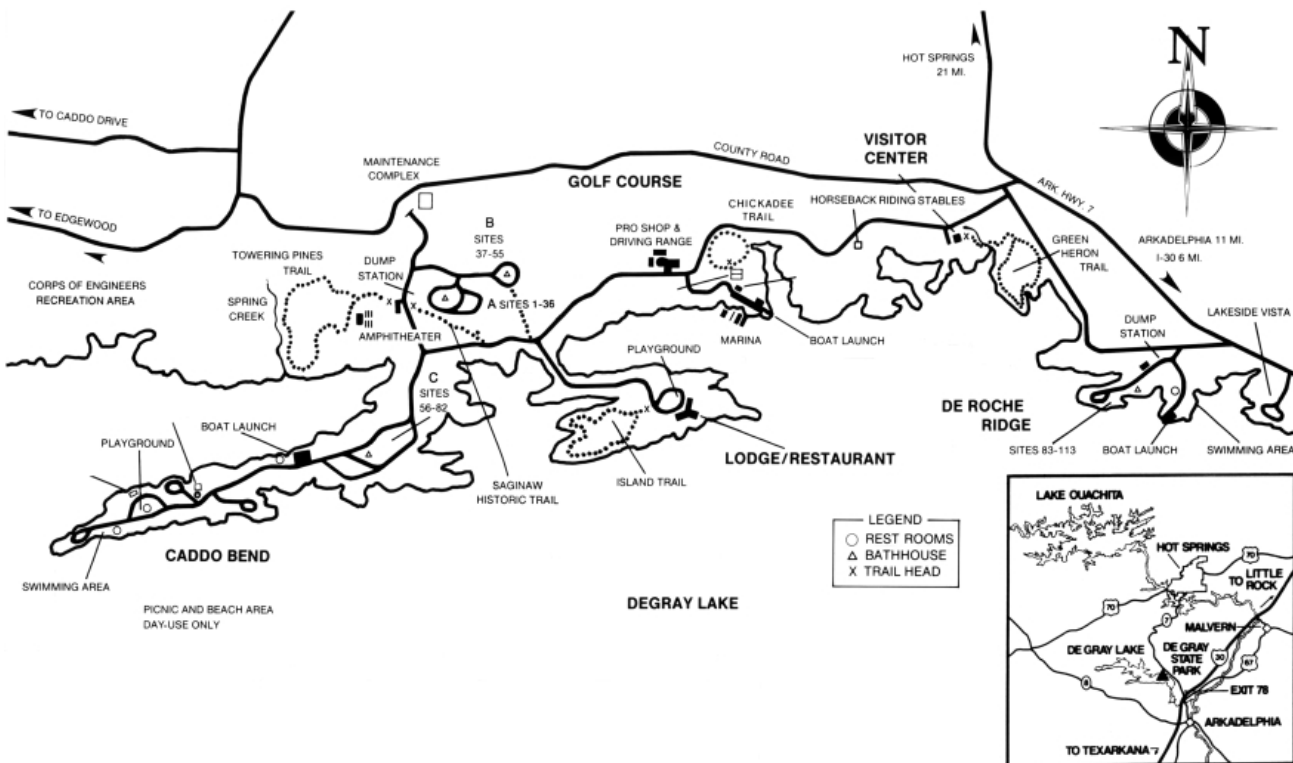
August Cruise to DeGray State Park
