MCA report: MCA Minutes of the meeting January 14, 2016.

Director Tom Sipes shared the following:

The MCA 40th Anniversary get-together will be held in Indianapolis. This will not be a judged event, but rather more like a show and shine. There will be track time available for the participants. For more information go to the MCA website.

Old business: Charities deferred to tonight.

Suggested organizations:

Private nonprofit organization in Perry County called KC Pet Rescue. This is 501C3 that works with a local vet office. It is run out of their own pocket. They do not euthanize pets but rather look for foster families, get the animal in good health, and adopt out of state.

Eureka Springs Turpentine Creek. This is an exotic animal rescue group located in Arkansas. There are cabins on the facility where visitors can stay and see the animals.

Mashburn Mustang Museum Inc. Museum was built and currently maintained out of their own pockets. The organization is 501C3 and houses the archives for the Central Arkansas Mustangers club.

Children's Hospital. Amazing work done for the children. Jerry has family members working there. David's grandson almost died before being brought to Children's. Also Brad and Brenda's grandson as well. Many members commented on the miracles witnessed at Children's.
