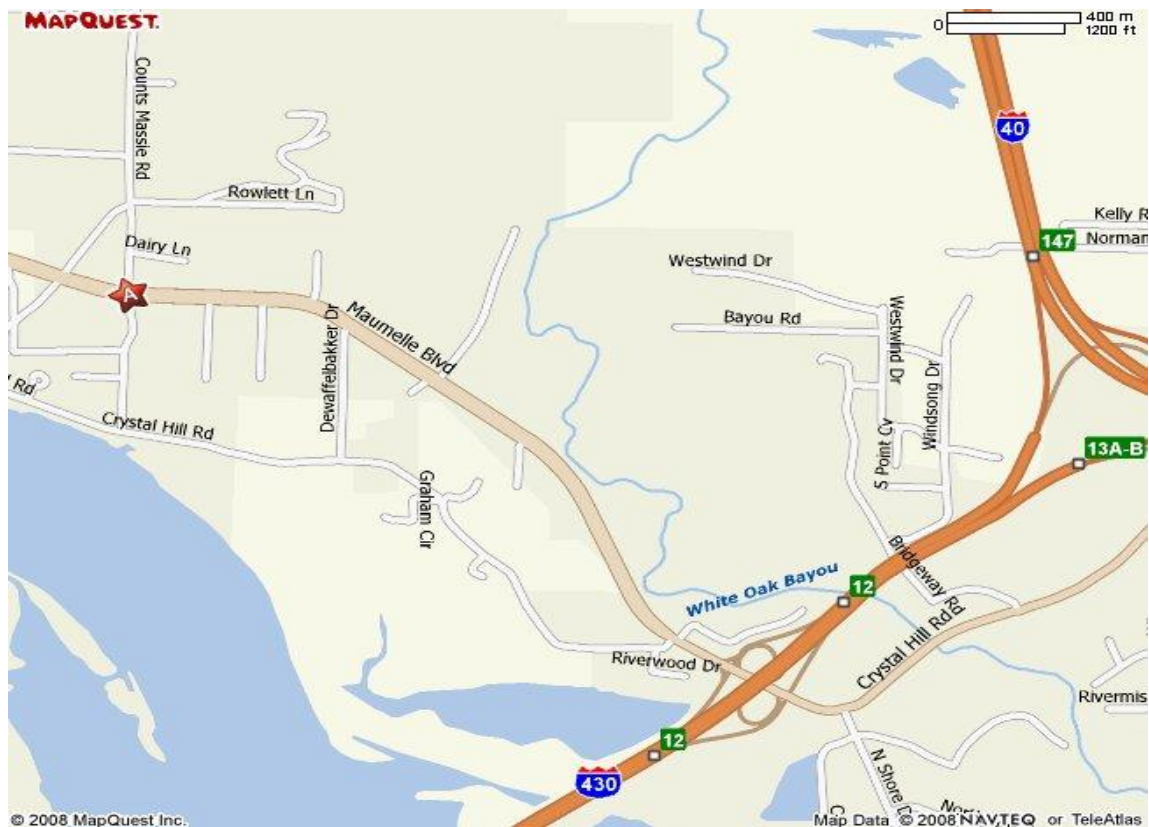
Saturday, January 24 @ 4:00 pm - Bowling at Millennium Bowl in Maumelle (see map below).
