Did You Know?

1987 Mustangs introduced a fairly new design. Most of the major, obvious changes were to the front end. The two separate square headlights were transformed into a large one piece headlight. The difference between the LX and GT models did become a bit more obvious that year, with the GT getting some extra body kit add-ons. The 87's engine bay could only be filled with 2 different motors this time: a 2.3L and the beefy 5.0.

The base price for a hardtop LX was \$8,271, \$8,690 for the hatchback, and \$12,106 for the hatchback GT. The convertible GT price was a whopping \$15,852.

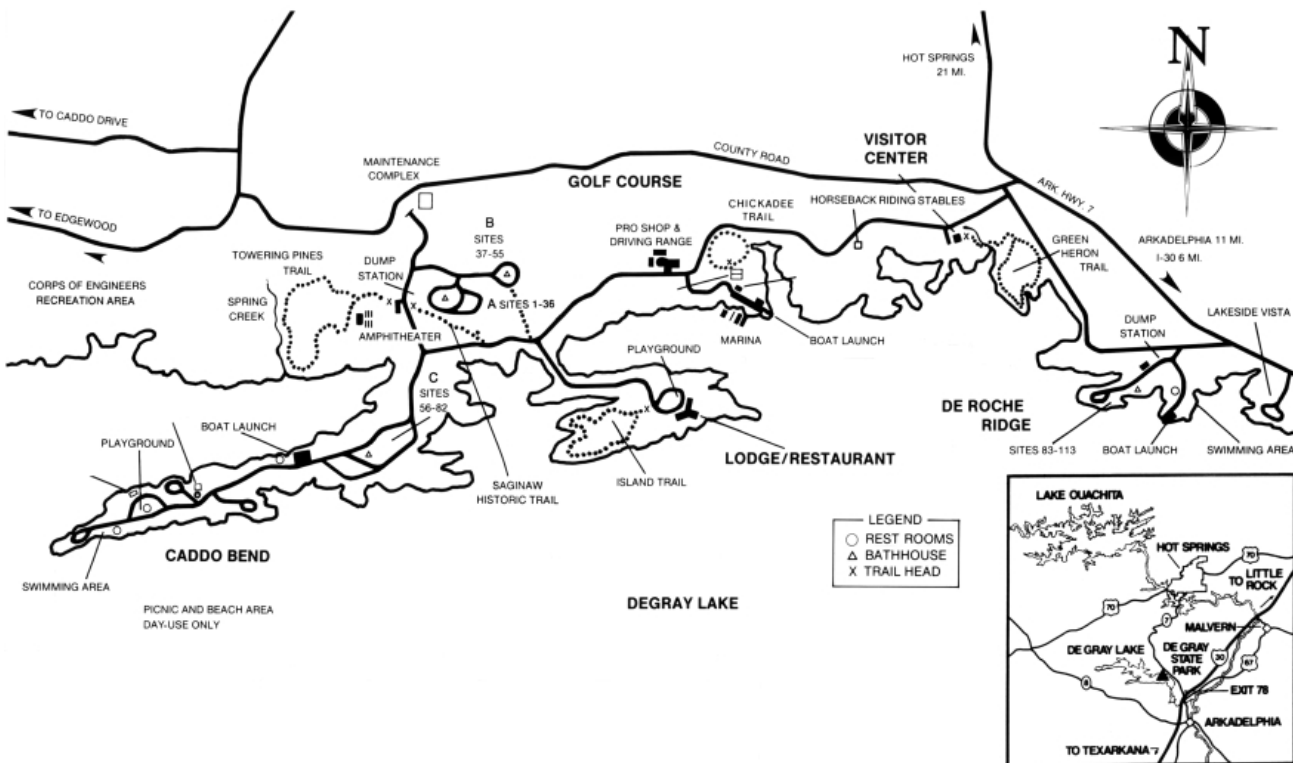
August Cruise to DeGray State Park
