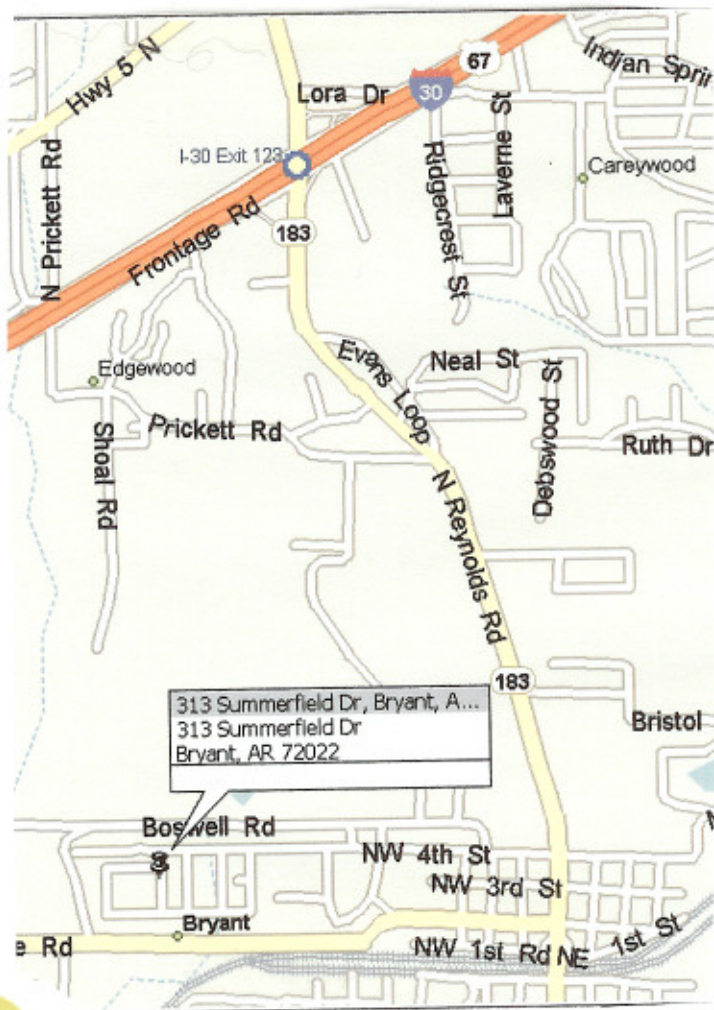
Show Report
