Did You Know?

The 2010 Mustang, while incorporating many of the basic mechanical components of its predecessor, with the addition of higher-spec components on the base models, the sum of all the parts equals a sporty car refined and cost efficient, while still visually attractive and fast, especially around corners.

This new era of Mustang maintains the same roof as the previous ones, but that is where the similarities end. The 2010 gets a totally new body. Start with the relocated antenna, hidden washers, recessed indicators and add a hood with a bulge and more creases in the body and it all combines for a distinct new attractive package.

The interior sports shiny new instrumentation, accented with Ford's own aluminum trim. LED lighting and soft touch plastics, not to mention more noise suppression, make for a pleasant driving environment.

While the same base engines are used, the v8 receives a cold air intake from Bullit, resulting in 315 hp and a .3 second improvement in the zero to sixty times. If you want even more power, adding premium fuel gains an amazing 10ft lb of torque from 1 to 4 thousand rpm.
