# 25th Annual Regional Show Analysis By David Green

Sunday, October 8, 2006 at Riser Ford in Hot Springs, Ark.:

- 110 cars registered, 105 judged. We had about 179 judged at the 1993 River City National Show. We had about 139 judged at the 1993 First Ever All-Arkansas Regional Mustang Show. CAM was host at both of those. We have had around 120 at a show-and-shine. But this is the most I know of at a judged Regional for us. We had 77 in 2005.
- Weather: morning low 44, afternoon high 77. Sunny all day after morning fog burned off. Perfect weather like 2005. *This is why we have our main show in early Octo-*

*ber.*

- Riser Ford is an excellent host for us. They gave us plenty of room and donated generous funds towards our awards. We get more out-of-town/state participants here than we do in Little Rock. *This is why we have our show in Hot Springs.*
- We did something new this year for the big 3" X 4" dash plaques, acrylic awards, and T-shirts using the digicolor format (unlimited colors and a digital background.) People seemed to like it.
- 3 PM trophy presentation time: we can't do it using our present sys-

tem at a judged show. Its OK for a show-n-shine. The judges did great, especially considering the huge and unexpected amount of cars we had. Five experienced people worked hard for 2.5 hours on the rankings. Even though I went from 51 awards to 66, we needed more—but who would have ever guessed at the turnout? We probably need 80 for next year. At least we had 94 dash plaques available; up from 70 last year and 80 approved for this year.

- The new 5th generation Mustangs are showing up in great numbers. I had given them more awards and split classes. It wasn't enough.
